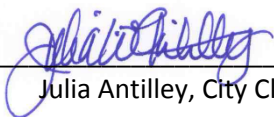

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A WAIVER OF PERMIT FEES; APPROVING A WAIVER OF LATE FEES; APPROVING A WAIVER OF CERTAIN ANIMAL SERVICES FEES; EXTENDING THE HOLD PERIOD FOR ALL STRAY ANIMALS; ACCEPTING AN EMERGENCY PURCHASE FOR DEBRIS MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL SERVICES PURSUANT TO TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE §252.022(A)(2); AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$250,000 FOR SERVICES RELATED TO STORM RECOVERY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2019 a severe thunderstorm swept through the City of San Angelo with a tornado causing a great deal of debris and property damage; and

WHEREAS, the damage from the storm included city-wide tree damage, damage to property and an increase in lost or stray animals; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2019 the Mayor issued a local disaster declaration related to the storm; and

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code §252.022(a)(2) provides an exception to the competitive bidding requirements for a procurement necessary to protect the public health or safety of the municipality's residents; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS THAT:

- PART 1: The City Council of the City of San Angelo, Texas, hereby waives the imposition and the collection of late fees under Sections 11.02.036 and A8.007 of the San Angelo Code of Ordinances for users of the City of San Angelo's municipal water utility for any late charges occurring after May 18, 2019 for all residents demonstrating they are located within the area of the City located north of 20th Street between Main Street and Poe and immediately adjacent streets for a period of 30 days past the date of this Resolution. All other storm related requests for late fee waiver from customers outside of this defined area will be evaluated on a case by case basis.
- PART 2: The City Council of the City of San Angelo, Texas, hereby waives the imposition and the collection of building permit fees under Sections A2.002, A2.003, A2.005, A2.006 and A2.007 of the San Angelo Code of Ordinances for the repair, replacement and removal of structures that is the result of damage from the May 18, 2019 storm for a period of 180 days past the date of this Resolution.
- PART 3: The City Council of the City of San Angelo, Texas hereby waives the imposition and the collection of impounding and boarding fees under A1.003 of the San Angelo Code of Ordinances for the redemption of stray animals until June 18, 2019.
- PART 4: The City Council of the City of San Angelo, Texas, suspends Section 3.05.002 of the San Angelo Code of Ordinances and hereby extends the hold period for all stray animals at the San Angelo Animal Shelter to 10 business days past the date of this Resolution.
- PART 5: The City Manager is hereby authorized to award a no-bid emergency contract to Compact Conservation and Construction, LLC pursuant to Texas Local Government Code §252.022(a)(2) and to negotiate and execute all related documents with that contractor for the management and chipping of brush debris.

PART 6: The City Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of up to \$250,000 for fees and services related to storm recovery. All monies authorized under this part shall come from the fund balance of the Solid Waste fund.

PART 7: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the authorizations of this Resolution.
