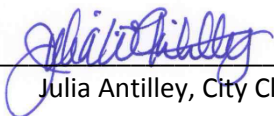

Summary/History:

The canvassing of elections is required by the Election Code to take place between 3 and 11 days following the election, after the Early Voting Ballot Board has verified and counted all provisional ballots.

While the final numbers from the EVBB will not be finalized until next week, the attached draft resolution shows the Unofficial Results as published Election Day, May 1, 2021.

The resolution will be updated with official numbers and Exhibit A will be added when available.

Financial Impact:

Election expenses will be shared on a prorata basis with San Angelo ISD, Water Valley ISD, and Grape Creek ISD are are estimated to be \$21,855.68.

Other Information/Recommendation:

Staff recommends adopting the resolution.

RESOLUTION 2021-0xx

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON THE 1ST DAY OF MAY, 2021, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING MUNICIPAL OFFICERS; DECLARING RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2021-014 of the City of San Angelo, Texas, adopted on the 19th day of January, 2021, a General Election was duly held on the 1st day of May, 2021, for the purpose of electing municipal officers to the following positions: Mayor and City Council Members for Single Member Districts Two, Four, and Six to four year terms; and

WHEREAS, the said General Election was posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law; and

WHEREAS, only duly qualified resident voters of the City of San Angelo, Texas, voted at the General Election called and held on May 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, section 67.003 of the Texas Election Code, as amended, generally provides that each local canvassing authority shall not convene for the purpose of canvassing the election results earlier than the later of the third day after the uniform election day in May, or the date on which the early voting ballot board has verified and counted all provisional ballots, if any, or the date on which all timely received ballots cast from addresses outside of the United States are counted, if any; and, not later than the eleventh day after the election day; and

WHEREAS, section 67.004(a) of the Texas Election Code, as amended, establishes the quorum level required to canvass election results to be two members of the canvassing authority; and

WHEREAS, a quorum of the City Council met on Wednesday, May 12, 2021, and duly canvassed the election returns of the above described General Election and Special Election, attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The City Council officially finds and determines that the said election was duly ordered to be held in the City of San Angelo, Texas on the 1st day of May, 2021, for the purpose of electing municipal officers to the following positions: Mayor, City Council Members for Single Member Districts Two, Four, and Six to four year terms; that proper notices of said elections were duly given; that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said elections; that said elections have been duly made and election returns delivered; and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns all in accordance with law.

Section 2: The City Council officially finds and determines that only qualified resident voters of the City of San Angelo were allowed to vote; the following votes were cast; the canvass of the votes cast in the May 1, 2021 election and returns thereof, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**, were made in accordance with the law.

Section 3: Pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Local Government Code, Texas Election Code, and the City of San Angelo, Texas Home-Rule Charter, the City Council officially finds, determines, and declares the results of said General Election to be that:

- (1) Brenda Gunter is elected Mayor to a four (4) year term of office by majority vote of the votes cast for Mayor; and
- (2) Tom Thompson is elected City Council Member for Single Member District Two to a four (4) year term of office by majority vote of the votes cast for Council Member Single Member District Two; and
- (3) Lucy Gonzales is elected City Council Member for Single Member District Four to a four (4) year term of office by majority vote of the votes cast for Council Member Single Member District Four; and
- (4) Larry Miller is elected City Council Member for Single Member District Six to a four (4) year term of office by majority vote of the votes cast for Council Member Single District Six.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
