1. Call to Order

With a quorum of the City Council Members present, Mayor Gunter called the regular session of the San Angelo City Council to order at 8:31 a.m. on Tuesday, February 1, 2022 in the San Angelo McNease Convention Center, 501 Rio Concho Drive, San Angelo, Texas 76903.

2. Chaplain Prayer & Pledges

An invocation was provided, and pledges were led, by San Angelo Police Department Chaplain Lorenzo Hatch.

3. Proclamations/Recognitions

Michael Hitchcock was recognized and honored for his retirement after 32 years of service with the City of San Angelo.

4. Public Comment

Eight citizens spoke in support of making San Angelo a Sanctuary City for the Unborn and requested the public hearing be moved to February 15, 2022.

Four residents spoke in favor: Calvary Baptist Church Pastor Bobby Rogers (SMD4), Deanery Pro-life Coordinator Stephanie Socha (SMD6), John Bariou (SMD2), and Dee Herring (SMD1)

Four non-residents spoke in favor: Grape Creek resident and Immanuel Baptist Church pastor Ryan Buck, Longview resident and Right to Life Founder Mark Lee Dickson, Mertzon resident and Pro-life Director for the Catholic diocese of San Angelo Jerry Peters, and Robert Lee resident Dwayne Welch

Motion: Council Member Miller made a motion, seconded by Council Member Thomas, to accept the certified petition, as presented, holding the public hearing during the March 1, 2022 City Council meeting, and directing the required newspaper publication. The motion carried (4) ayes to (1) nay, with Council Member Gonzales casting the dissenting vote.
