RESOLUTION 2024-000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON THE 4TH DAY OF MAY 2024, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A POLICE CHIEF; DECLARING RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2024-010 of the City of San Angelo, Texas, adopted on the 6th day of February 2024, a General Election was duly held on the 4th day of May 2024, for the purpose of electing a Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, the said General Election was posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law; and

WHEREAS, only duly qualified resident voters of the City of San Angelo, Texas, voted at the General Election held on May 4, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.003 of the Texas Election Code, as amended, generally provides that each local canvassing authority shall not convene for the purpose of canvassing the election results earlier than the later of the third day after the election day, or the date on which the early voting ballot board has verified and counted all provisional ballots, if any, or the date on which all timely received ballots cast from addresses outside of the United States are counted, if any; and, not later than the eleventh day after the election day; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.004(a) of the Texas Election Code, as amended, establishes the quorum level required to canvass election results to be two members of the canvassing authority; and

WHEREAS, a quorum of the City Council met on Wednesday, May 15, 2024, and duly canvassed the election returns of the above described General Election, attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The City Council officially finds and determines that the said election was duly ordered to be held in the City of San Angelo, Texas on the 4th day of May 2024, for the purpose of electing a Police Chief; that proper notices of said election were duly given; that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said elections; that said election has been duly made and election returns delivered; and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns all in accordance with law.

Section 2: The City Council officially finds and determines that only qualified resident voters of the City of San Angelo were allowed to vote; the following votes were cast; the canvass of the votes cast in the May 4, 2024 election and returns thereof, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**, were made in accordance with the law.

Section 3: Pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Local Government Code, Texas Election Code, and the City of San Angelo, Texas Home-Rule Charter, the City Council officially finds, determines, and declares the results of said General Election to be that:

- (1) No candidate for the position of Police Chief received a majority of votes cast and a runoff election shall be called for June 15, 2024, between Travis Griffith and Mike Hernandez, the two candidates having received the highest and second highest number of votes asset for the positions of Police Chief.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.

The above Resolution was, upon motion made by Council Member _____ and seconded by Council Member _____, ADOPTED by the City Council of San Angelo, Texas on the 15th day of May 2024.

RESOLUTION 2024-000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS, ORDERING A RUNOFF ELECTION BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON THE 15TH DAY OF JUNE 2024, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A POLICE CHIEF FOR A THREE YEAR TERM; DESIGNATING LOCATIONS OF POLLING PLACES; PROVIDING FOR DATES, TIMES AND PLACE FOR EARLY VOTING BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE; AUTHORIZING A JOINT ELECTION WITH SUCH OTHER LOCAL POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS THAT JOIN IN A JOINT ELECTION INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY AND CITY; MAKING PROVISIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION AND OTHER PROVISIONS INCIDENTAL AND RELATED TO THE PURPOSE OF THIS RESOLUTION; ORDERING PUBLICATION; PROVIDING FOR SERVABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2024-010 of the City of San Angelo, Texas, adopted on the 6th day of February 2024, a General Election was duly held on the 4th day of May 2024, for the purpose of electing a Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on canvassing the returns of the general election for Police Chief has determined that no candidate received a majority of votes cast for that office, and that Travis Griffith and Mike Hernandez are the two candidates having received the highest and second highest number of votes cast for the positions of Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, Section 45 of the City Charter and state law provides that where in any election no candidate receives the majority of all the votes cast for such office, the Council shall immediately upon declaring the official results of the election, issue a call for a runoff election for each position to which no one was elected; and

WHEREAS, Tom Green County Election Administration and the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement effective January 1, 2023, and automatically renewing annually through December 31, 2032, stipulating for election services to be provided by Tom Green County election Administration in anticipation of holding elections from and after May 2023 through November 2032; and

WHEREAS, the meeting at which this resolution was considered was open to the public as required by law, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by Title 5, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The recitals stated in the preamble hereof are found to be true and correct and are adopted as a part of this resolution.

Section 2: The City Council hereby orders a Runoff Election to be held on the 15th day of June 2024, which is not earlier than twenty (20) days or later than the forty-fifth (45) day after the final canvassing of the General Election in compliance with Section 2.025(b) of the Texas election Code and pursuant to Section 45 of the City Charter, for the purpose of electing a Police Chief to serve a three-year term.

Section 3: The runoff election ordered to be held on Saturday, June 15, 2024, shall be held jointly with such school districts or other local political subdivisions that opt to enter into an agreement for election services as authorized under Section 271.002 of the Texas Election Code.

Section 4: The official ballots for said election shall conform to the Texas Election Code, as amended, to permit the electors to vote for the candidate of their choice, with the official ballot to contain such other provisions, markings and language as required by law.

Section 5: Early Voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the Edd B. and Frances Frink Keyes Building in the Elections Office on the First Floor during the following days/times:

June 3 – June 7, 2024 from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

June 10 – June 11, 2024 from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

The City will utilize multiple early voting branch locations adopted by Resolution and designated by TGC as outlined in the Election Code Section 42.002 entitled “required Use of County Precincts” when needed. The June 15, 2024, election does not meet the outlined requirements for county precincts.

Section 6: The Election Day polling places where qualified voters shall cast ballots will be at the locations designated by Tom Green County pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 42.002 set forth in **Exhibit “A”**, attached hereto and adopted as part of this Resolution.

Section 7: The City of San Angelo authorized the Tom Green County Elections Administrator, as the Contracting Officer, to make any necessary changes to election judges and/or polling locations without further action by City Council or approval by the City of San Angelo, to include the selection of additional people/places, or changes to existing people/places, or moving the election judges/alternates from one location to another.

Section 8: Said election shall be conducted using the voting systems adopted by TGC under Section 123.001b3B of the Texas Election Code with the same terms approved by the County and the results canvassed and announced as prescribed by the Texas Election Code, as amended and only duly qualified electors shall be qualified to vote.

Section 9: The City Clerk is directed and required to publish a notice of said elections as required by law.

Section 10: The terms and provisions of this Resolution shall be deemed to be severable in that if any portion of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

Section 11: It is officially determined and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given as required by Chapter 551, as amended, of the Texas Government Code.

Section 12: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to hold a runoff election on June 15, 2024, including but not limited to, a contract with the county, and any related documents with other entities holding an election with TGC on the same day.

Section 13: This Resolution shall be effective from and after the date of its adoption.

CONSIDERANDO QUE, de conformidad con la Resolución 2024-010 de la Ciudad de San Angelo, Texas, adoptada el día 6 de febrero de 2024, se llevó a cabo una Elección General el día 4 de mayo de 2024, con el propósito de elegir un Jefe de Policía; y
