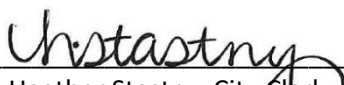

RESOLUTION 2024-045

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS OF THE RUNOFF ELECTION HELD ON THE 15TH DAY OF JUNE 2024, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A POLICE CHIEF; DECLARING RESULTS OF THE RUNOFF ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2024-034 of the City of San Angelo, Texas, adopted on the 15th day of May 2024, a Runoff Election was duly held on the 15th day of June 2024, for the purpose of electing a Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, the said Runoff Election was posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law; and

WHEREAS, only duly qualified resident voters of the City of San Angelo, Texas, voted at the Runoff Election held on June 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.003 of the Texas Election Code, as amended, generally provides that each local canvassing authority shall not convene for the purpose of canvassing the election results earlier than the later of the third day after the election day, or the date on which the early voting ballot board has verified and counted all provisional ballots, if any, or the date on which all timely received ballots cast from addresses outside of the United States are counted, if any; and, not later than the eleventh day after the election day; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.004(a) of the Texas Election Code, as amended, establishes the quorum level required to canvass election results to be two members of the canvassing authority; and

WHEREAS, a quorum of the City Council met on Wednesday, June 26, 2024, and duly canvassed the election returns of the above described Runoff Election, attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The City Council officially finds and determines that the said election was duly ordered to be held in the City of San Angelo, Texas on the 15th day of June 2024, for the purpose of electing a Police Chief; that proper notices of said election were duly given; that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said elections; that said election has been duly made and election returns delivered; and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns all in accordance with law.

Section 2: The City Council officially finds and determines that only qualified resident voters of the City of San Angelo were allowed to vote; the following votes were cast; the canvass of the votes cast in the June 15, 2024 runoff election and returns thereof, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**, were made in accordance with the law.

Section 3: Pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Local Government Code, Texas Election Code, and the City of San Angelo, Texas Home-Rule Charter, the City Council officially finds, determines, and declares the results of said General Election to be that:

- (1) Travis Griffith is elected Police Chief for the City of San Angelo to a three-year term of office ending May 2027 by majority vote of the votes cast for Police Chief.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
