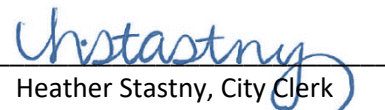

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-_____

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A
BOND ELECTION; AND OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the City Council (the *Council*) of the City of San Angelo, Texas (the *City*) ordered an election to be held on May 3, 2025 for the purpose of determining whether the qualified voters of the City would authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to this election, including the election ordinance, notices, officers, holding, and returns thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Council has diligently inquired into the poll lists and the official election returns which were duly and lawfully made to the Council by the judges and clerks holding and conducting such election; the poll lists and the official election returns showing separately the votes cast in the election; and

WHEREAS, the precinct returns are attached and incorporated for all purposes; and

WHEREAS, from these returns, this Council hereby finds that the following votes were cast in the election by voters who were qualified voters of the City:

PROPOSITION A

The issuance of bonds in the amount of \$41,660,000 for promoting economic development by renovating the City's Coliseum and Fairgrounds and the levy of taxes sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS
THAT:

SECTION 1: The Council officially finds, determines, and declares that the election was properly ordered, that legal notice of such election was properly given, that proper election officers were appointed prior to the election, that the election was legally held, that all qualified voters of the City were permitted to vote at the election, that due returns of the results of the

election had been made and delivered, and that the Council has duly canvassed such returns, all in accordance with state and federal laws and the document calling the election.

SECTION 2: A MAJORITY of the qualified voters of the City of San Angelo, Texas voting in such election, having voted FOR Proposition A, the Council hereby finds and determines this Proposition carried at the election, and that the Council is hereby accordingly authorized to issue the bonds and to levy the tax in accordance with the law and the authority granted in the Proposition and corresponding Measure stated in the City's election order.

SECTION 3: The City's Mayor is authorized to execute this Ordinance, and the City's Secretary is authorized to certify this Ordinance regardless of their participation in the quorum required by the Election Code.

SECTION 4: The recitals contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the Council.

SECTION 5: All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

SECTION 7: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the Council hereby declares that this Ordinance would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

SECTION 8: It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Ordinance, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

SECTION 9: This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its final passage and it is so resolved.

RESOLUTION 2025-000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON THE 3RD DAY OF MAY 2025, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR SINGLE MEMBER DISTRICTS TWO, FOUR, AND SIX; DECLARING RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2025-013 of the City of San Angelo, Texas, adopted on the 4th day of February 2025, a General Election was duly held on the 3rd day of May 2025, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Council Members for Single Member Districts Two, Four, and Six; and

WHEREAS, the said General Election was posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.053 of the Texas Election Code, on the 4th day of March 2025, City Council cancelled the election for City Council Member for Single Member District Six, and declared the unopposed candidate elected to office; and

WHEREAS, only duly qualified resident voters of the City of San Angelo, Texas, voted at the General Election held on May 3, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.003 of the Texas Election Code, as amended, generally provides that each local canvassing authority shall not convene for the purpose of canvassing the election results earlier than the later of the third day after the election day, or the date on which the early voting ballot board has verified and counted all provisional ballots, if any, or the date on which all timely received ballots cast from addresses outside of the United States are counted, if any; and, not later than the eleventh day after the election day; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.004(a) of the Texas Election Code, as amended, establishes the quorum level required to canvass election results to be two members of the canvassing authority; and

WHEREAS, a quorum of the City Council met on Wednesday, May 14, 2025, and duly canvassed the election returns of the above described General Election, attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The City Council officially finds and determines that the said election was duly ordered to be held in the City of San Angelo, Texas on the 3rd day of May 2025, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and City Council Members for Single Member Districts Two and Four to a four year term ending May 2029; that proper notices of said election were duly given; that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said elections; that said election has been duly made and election returns delivered; and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns all in accordance with law.

Section 2: The City Council officially finds and determines that only qualified resident voters of the City of San Angelo were allowed to vote; the following votes were cast; the canvass of the votes cast in the May 3, 2025, election and returns thereof, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**, were made in accordance with the law.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS, ORDERING A RUNOFF ELECTION BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON THE 7TH DAY OF JUNE 2025, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY COUNCIL MEMBER FOR SINGLE MEMBER DISTRICT TWO TO A FOUR-YEAR TERM; DESIGNATING LOCATIONS OF POLLING PLACES; PROVIDING FOR DATES, TIMES AND PLACE FOR EARLY VOTING BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE; AUTHORIZING A JOINT ELECTION WITH SUCH OTHER LOCAL POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS THAT JOIN IN A JOINT ELECTION INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY AND CITY; MAKING PROVISIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION AND OTHER PROVISIONS INCIDENTAL AND RELATED TO THE PURPOSE OF THIS RESOLUTION; ORDERING PUBLICATION; PROVIDING FOR SERVABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2025-013 of the City of San Angelo, Texas, adopted on the 4th day of February 2025, a General Election was duly held on the 3rd day of May 2025, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, and City Council Members for Single Member Districts Two, Four, and Six; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on canvassing the returns of the general election for City Council Member for Single Member District Two has determined that no candidate received a majority of votes cast for that office, and that Dudra Butler and Joe Self are the two candidates having received the highest and second highest number of votes cast for the positions of City Council Member for Single Member District Two; and

WHEREAS, Section 45 of the City Charter and state law provides that where in any election no candidate receives the majority of all the votes cast for such office, the Council shall immediately upon declaring the official results of the election, issue a call for a runoff election for each position to which no one was elected; and

WHEREAS, Tom Green County Election Administration and the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement effective January 1, 2023, and automatically renewing annually through December 31, 2032, stipulating for election services to be provided by Tom Green County election Administration in anticipation of holding elections from and after May 2023 through November 2032; and

WHEREAS, the meeting at which this resolution was considered was open to the public as required by law, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by Title 5, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The recitals stated in the preamble hereof are found to be true and correct and are adopted as a part of this resolution.

Section 2: The City Council hereby orders a Runoff Election to be held on the 7th day of June 2025, which is not earlier than twenty (20) days or later than the forty-fifth (45) day after the final canvassing of the General Election in compliance with Section 2.025(b) of the Texas election Code and pursuant to Section 45 of the City Charter, for the purpose of electing a City Council Member for Single Member District Two to serve a four year term.

Section 3: The runoff election ordered to be held on Saturday, June 7, 2025, shall be held jointly with such school districts or other local political subdivisions that opt to enter into an agreement for election services as authorized under Section 271.002 of the Texas Election Code.

Section 4: The official ballots for said election shall conform to the Texas Election Code, as amended, to permit the electors to vote for the candidate of their choice, with the official ballot to contain such other provisions, markings and language as required by law.

Section 5: Early Voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the Edd B. and Frances Frink Keyes Building in the Elections Office on the First Floor during the following days/times:

May 27 – May 31, 2025 from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

June 1, 2025 from 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M.

June 2 – June 3, 2025 from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

The City will utilize multiple early voting branch locations adopted by Resolution and designated by TGC as outlined in the Election Code Section 42.002 entitled “required Use of County Precincts” when needed. The June 7, 2025, election does not meet the outlined requirements for county precincts.

Section 6: The Election Day polling places where qualified voters shall cast ballots will be at the locations designated by Tom Green County pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 42.002 set forth in **Exhibit “A”**, attached hereto and adopted as part of this Resolution.

Section 7: The City of San Angelo authorized the Tom Green County Elections Administrator, as the Contracting Officer, to make any necessary changes to election judges and/or polling locations without further action by City Council or approval by the City of San Angelo, to include the selection of additional people/places, or changes to existing people/places, or moving the election judges/alternates from one location to another.

Section 8: Said election shall be conducted using the voting systems adopted by TGC under Section 123.001b3B of the Texas Election Code with the same terms approved by the County and the results canvassed and announced as prescribed by the Texas Election Code, as amended and only duly qualified electors shall be qualified to vote.

Section 9: The City Clerk is directed and required to publish a notice of said elections as required by law.

Section 10: The terms and provisions of this Resolution shall be deemed to be severable in that if any portion of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

Section 11: It is officially determined and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given as required by Chapter 551, as amended, of the Texas Government Code.

CONSIDERANDO QUE, de conformidad con la Resolución 2025-013 de la Ciudad de San Angelo, Texas, adoptada el día 4 de febrero de 2025, se llevó a cabo una Elección General el día 3 de mayo de 2025, con el propósito de elegir un Alcalde y un Miembro del Concejo Municipal para los Distritos Uninominales Dos, Cuatro y Seis; y
