January 2018 marked 22 months in a row where no adoptable animal was euthanized.

404 new animals arrived in the shelter during January. 166 were adopted, 55 were redeemed by their owner, 221 were euthanized and 227 were left in the shelter at month end.

Our live release rate was 66.03%.

20 citizens used the microchip clinic.

February 2018 marked 23 months in a row where no adoptable animal was euthanized.

406 new animals arrived in the shelter during February. 178 were adopted, 60 were redeemed by their owner, 173 were euthanized and 208 were left in the shelter at month end.

Our live release rate was 71.54%.

25 citizens used the microchip clinic.
