**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING
TOM GREEN COUNTY IN THEIR EFFORTS TO AMEND THE DEFENSE ECONOMIC
ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE GRANT SUPPORTING THE GOODFELLOW AIR
FORCE BASE**

WHEREAS, Goodfellow Air Force Base (“GAFB”) is located in the City of San Angelo (“City”), Tom Green County (“TGC”), Texas and is the City’s largest employer; and,

WHEREAS, the mission of GAFB is intelligence, surveillance, reconnaissance, and fire training for all branches of the United States Military; and, TGC; and,

WHEREAS, the Texas Military Preparedness Commission within the Office of the Governor of Texas established a grant program known as the Defense Economic Adjustment Assistance (“DEAA”) to provide state funding for the following; acquiring federal grant assistance, for sharing in the cost of redevelopment of communities that have been adversely or positively affected by the Base Realignment and Closure Act or Department of Defense reduction or loss of funding; or, in the case of infrastructure, adds military value installation; and,

WHEREAS, this program enabled GAFB to renovate two buildings in 2017 for intelligence training that was extended to 32 allied countries; and,

WHEREAS, GAFB with the support of TGC and the City of San Angelo Development Corporation was awarded a Defense Economic Adjustment Grant on December 15, 2017 to expand a dining facility, renovate two classroom training facilities, deliver capital equipment and develop a new joint center for targeting and weaponry; and,

WHEREAS, the Texas Military Preparedness Commission has indicated additional funding is available for the current projects upon request and amended application; and,

WHEREAS, the City is honored by the recognition and support Governor Abbott and the State of Texas has previously shown Goodfellow Air Force Base.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The City of San Angelo City Council recognizes the importance of Good Fellow Air Force Base to the success of the mission of our military and is hereby fully supports Tom Green County’s efforts to seek an amendment to the Defense Economic Adjustment Assistance Grant and the request for additional funding from the Texas Military Preparedness Commission to support the vital operations of Goodfellow Air Force Base.
